



two weeks and have a response deadline of February 8. Once they receive qualifications the committee will rank the top three and then they will ask for prices based on their RFQ's. This is following the law director's recommended procedure. He said the total project cost budget will not exceed \$4 mil and they will be upfront with all the contractors that this is the maximum, but obviously the city would like less. He said they once they select a firm and get prices they would like substantial completion by the end of this year.

Amy Hendricks stated she had Sudsina rerun the numbers with the current interest rate requirement and the municipal bond rates have dropped a little bit, so it gives more availability of funds.

Chairman Frank Loucka adjourned the meeting after no further discussion came before the committee.
